



School Guidelines for our pupils

We have various guidelines which you will find as you read through this Prospectus. Other rules are :

- All childrens behaviour and manners should be exemplary.
- All clothing is to be clearly labelled.
- Sweets or unhealthy snacks in packed lunches are not allowed.
- Only sugar free non-fizzy drinks are allowed.
- We can only accept responsibility for administering medicines during the school day, with written permission stating the exact dosage. Inhalers are governed by the School Asthma Policy.
- All pupils are expected to adhere to a high standard of dress.
- Watches and pierced stud earrings (one in each ear) are the only jewellery permitted in school.
- We encourage children with long hair to tie it back
- Boys hair should be above the collar.

We operate a Positive Behaviour Policy which aims to prevent bullying and encourages children to be kind, to help each other, to walk away from trouble, to smile, to look after one another and to be courteous. Positive action is acknowledged and rewarded with raffle tickets, stickers, public praise, team points, certificates & badges and positions of responsibility. Our Positive Behaviour Policy booklet is distributed to all families each September.

Each September our families and pupils are invited to sign our 'Home School Agreement'. This pledges that the staff, parents and pupils will work together to support the progress of Woodheys' children.

Alongside the 'Home School Agreement', a Homework guide and 'How to Support your child at Home' booklet are also given to each family. These clearly outline the expectations of the school of the pupil and his/her family. Parents should always communicate if their child is experiencing any problems, staff are available with notice, to meet parents.

Both parents and children know that for safety reasons all children must be signed in or out if they leave the school building. All visitors must sign the visitors' book and wear a 'smiley' welcome badge.

At Key Stage 2 children are members of house groups, which at Woodheys are named after local Halls - Dunham, blue; Gawsworth, red; Lyme, green; Tatton, yellow.

The school colours are navy and red. School uniform is as follows :

Boys: Navy jumper, dark grey trousers, white shirt and school tie
(red & navy stripe.)
Summer : Short sleeved white polo shirt. Shorts may be worn.

Girls: Navy skirt or pinafore, grey school trousers, navy cardigan or jumper, white blouse and school tie.
Summer : Blue & white check dress, white socks. Year 5/6 girls may wear white polo shirts and grey skirts.

Training shoes should not be worn as everyday footwear.

School uniform may be purchased from the 'Uniform Shop', which is run by the Parents' Association, on Monday afternoons from 3.00 - 3.30 pm. Jumpers, cardigans, ties, polo shirts and summer baseball caps can be purchased.

All children should have pumps for indoor P.E. At Key Stage 1 children require a white T-shirt and navy shorts for outdoor games. At Key Stage 2 T-shirts in house colours are worn with navy shorts or netball skirts. T-shirts are also available from the 'Uniform Shop'.
